Fundraising: Summit County Youth to Youth primarily functions off of fundraising dollars. We are able to provide financial assistance and help our students attend activities/events/trainings, etc. Because of this, participation in fundraising initiatives are MANDATORY. We will make every effort to help each youth staff member successfully fundraise.

Other Volunteer Opportunities: Our program is well-known throughout Summit County. We are frequently invited to participate in community programs that we ask our youth to attend and help with. These opportunities will be communicated as they become available. They include events such as school open houses, health fairs, community fairs, Summit for Kids, etc.

Contract Info: All youth staff and their parents will be required to sign a contract to join the staff. This contract explains the expectations of each staff member and their parents, who play an important role in the success of this program. It includes things like remaining abstinent from substance abuse, taking care of one's mental health, meeting attendance requirements, fundraising requirements, parental commitment requirements, and other important information. We use this contract to guide our decisions throughout the year for staff that do not uphold their commitment. Please note that these are handled on a case by case basis and many factors are taken into consideration.
